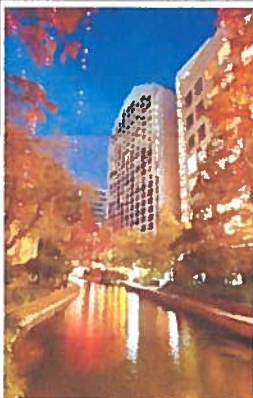


Historical sites of Bexar
